After the 3rd edition of “Dog Training for Dummies” was written in early 2010, the FDA has made it impossible for us to make up Homeopathic First Aid Kits. For most companies making them, they too have withdrawn their kits from the market.

You can make up your own Emergency Kit by taking the homeopathics listed in the book and buy them individually. We suggest a 30c potency. Keep them in a small. Waterproof cosmetics bag and take them with you when you and your dog leave home. Keep in a cool place.

Recommendations for making up your own Kit:

- * **Arnica:** Bruising from falls and dog bites and recuperation from any operation
- * **Belladonna:** Heat stroke, hot, red ears, and hot spots
- * **Carbo Veg:** Bloating or gas (settles the stomach if used 15 minutes before eating)
- * **Chamomilla:** Vomiting of yellow bile and teething problems
- * **Ferrum Phos:** Stops bleeding
- * **Hydrophobinum (or Lyssin):** Reactions to rabies vaccine
- * **Hypericum:** Stops pain to nerve endings after injury or operations
- * **Ignatia:** Grief, insecurity, stress, or sadness
- * **Ledum:** Tick, insect, or spider bites
- * **Nux Vomica:** Any kind of poisoning; recuperation after anesthesia
- * **Phosphorus:** Sound sensitivity
- * **Rhus Tox (poison ivy):** Rheumatism and itchy, oozing rashes

- * **Sulphur:** Skin conditions and mange
- * **Thuja:** Reactions to vaccines
- * **Rescue Remedy:** This is a Bach Flower Remedy in a liquid form. Use for stress and or trauma (We always carry it when we travel with our dogs.)
